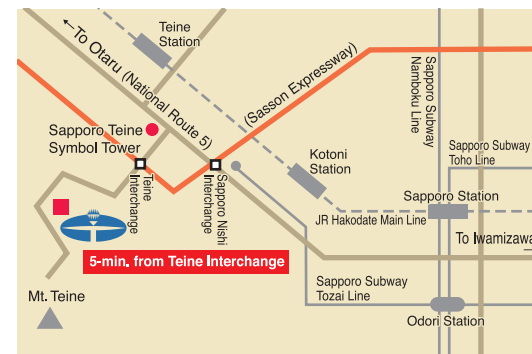


Restaurant *Fuki no To*

(via the Hokkaido/Sasson Expressway)



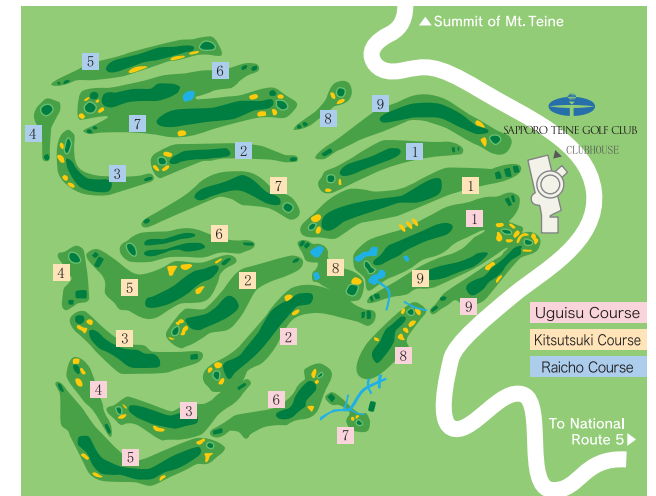

Sapporo Teine Golf Club is known for its breathtaking views of Mt. Teine, an iconic landmark of Sapporo, as well as the blue rippling waves of Ishikari Bay.

On clear days golfers are greeted by views of the Mashike Range in the distance and the never-ending chorus of bird songs from the surrounding forest.

Each of the course's three 9-hole courses presents golfers with unique obstacles and challenges that require clever play and strategies.



Uguisu Course

The Uguisu Course offers a highly challenging layout filled with undulating fairways and greens, demanding distance with accuracy and strategic layups throughout. The par-4 number six hole features a famous bunker shaped like Hokkaido.

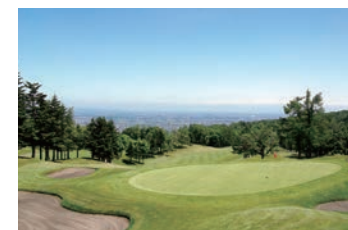

Kitsutsuki Course
